



WHEREAS: the Settler is keen and earnest desire to serve mankind in general and people of India by creating a Public Charitable Trust for the purposes as mentioned in the objective clause of the Trust. The above named Trustee has at the request of the Settler agreed to act as the first Trustee of these presents upon the terms and provisions herein contained.

NOW THIS TRUST DEED WITNESSES AS FOLLOWES:

That for the purpose of establishing a permanent trust to be 1. named as AL-FURQUAN EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE TRUST to carry out the objective of the said Trust hereinafter mentioned under objective clause and for the purpose, the Settler has contributed initially a sum of Rs. 1,50,000/-(Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) towards Corpus Fund and made deliver/ handed over the same to the Trustees with intend to part with all his rights, title and interest claim therein and vest the same in the Trustees to have and to hold the same and the investment or the investments for the time being representing the same and all other properties that may for the time being represent the Trust estate together with all additions and accretions thereto and all accumulated income thereof and all other property or properties that may be acquired out of the same or otherwise may hereafter be subject to the Trust

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for the charitable objects, purpose and uses hereinafter expressed with the powers and on the terms and conditions herein in contained of the concerning the same.

- 2. That the name of the Trust shall be "AL-FURQUAN EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE TRUST" (hereinafter called the "Trust")
- That the Registered Office of the Trust shall be situated at Mazar Chowk, Pilkhana Road, Mohiuddinpur, P.o+P.s-Kishanganj, Dist-Kishanganj, Bihar 855108 or such other place or places as may from time to time, be decided by the Trustees.
- AL-FURQUAN EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE TRUST is a public charitable trust. It is established with a vision of "to Create the ambience with Fragrance of love-& brotherhood among the people of India, to fulfill an aim of "to improve the qualities of basic necessities of life in the field of Health, Education, Livelihood & Poverty (HELP) among the needy & poor people and purifies the soul of rich & pious people in society" with the objectives of "all activities of AL-FURQUAN EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE TRUST will be done towards the needy and poor people for the sake of love with Almighty thorough the help of good doers". AL-FURQUAN EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE TRUST works under the guidance of Trustee and Trust Board member with scholars who ensure that the charity's role as a trustee is always fulfilled, Knowing that we are all ultimately accountable to the Almighty, the charity strives to maintain transparency and accountability.

5. THE AREA OF OPERATION:

The area of operation of the Trust shall be All Over India to serve the people of India and it could have its branch offices at any place in India or abroad.

6. Those who are the Trustees for the purpose and declare that the Settler will continue to be the Managing Trustee/President of the Trust and one of the Trustees for his life time.

7. That the ownership, management and control of the trust properties shall be vest in the Board of the Trustees. The above mention Trustees shall be members of the first Board of Trustees and shall also be called and referred as Founder Trustees.

8. IRREVOCABLE: That The Trust is irrevocable.

MANAGING TRUSTEE:

The Managing Trustee shall have all the powers of managing the Trust and its properties, sign documents, statements, affidavits, declaration, returns etc. The Board of Trustee shall have one Chairman. The first Chairman shall be **SYED SHAMSUDDIN** who shall preside all over the meeting of the Board of Trustees and shall be the Principal Executive office of the Trust and shall hold the office of the Chairman for life time. During his lifetime he may nominate one Trust -cum -Chairman as his successor in office.

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Oslockum The Trustee -cumChairman so nominated shall enter the office after the lifetime of the Present Chairman. If the present Chairman falls to nominate his successor, after his lifetime the remaining Trustee shall elect one amongst, them-selves the next Chairman. For the Trust, appoint, transfer and terminate comployee, open and operate Bank Accounts and attend to the day to day management of the affairs of the Trust. He/She shall represent the Trust in all matters before all authorities, courts, Government Departments and all bodies. He/she shall do any act, deed or thing necessary for carrying out the objects or works of the Trust subject to the directions of the Board of Trustees. Any other person may be authorized to do the same.

THAT THE MAIN OBJECTS OF THE TRUST ARE:-

A. EDUCATION

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- i. To establish, run, support and grant aid or other financial assistance to schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, universities, laboratories, research and other institutions of the like nature in India, for use of the students and the staff and also for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general.
- ii. To establish, develop, run, maintain and grant aid in cash or in kind to schools, medical colleges, law College, nursing institutions, dispensaries, mobile dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centers and/or such other similar charitable institutions in India for the benefit and use of the general public
- iii. To start, establish, run, take over or manage and maintain the schools, with the object to provide Sound Nursery, Pre Primary, Primary, Middle, Secondary, Senior Secondary and Higher Education to children / students by seeking recognition and affiliation from the Education Departments etc.
- iv. To offer prizes in cash or in kind and grant scholarship to deserving students and also to provide all possible facilities to thestudents.

Establishment and maintenance and support of Hostels and/or Boarding Houses and grant of free Boarding and Lodging to poor and deserving students upon such terms and for such period in each case as the Trustees think fit | irrespectively of religion or caste.

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vi. Grant of Endowments at the Universities, Research Institutions and Other Educational and Scientific Institution (Whether now existing or hereinafter established) for spread of education and knowledge in all or any branches of knowledge.

B. MEDICAL RELIEF

- i. To establish, develop, run, maintain and grant aid in cash or in kind to hospitals, medical schools, medical colleges, nursing institutions, dispensaries, mobile dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centers and/or such other similar charitable institutions in India for the benefit and use of the general public
- ii. To make arrangement for mobile emergency Van / Ambulance for the victims of road-accidents, to provide help to pregnant ladies to shift them to nearby hospital, also to provide assistance to the old people for the emergency.
- iii. To open centers / institutes for diagnostic curative and research of Cancer, AIDS, T.B. and other deadly diseases.
- iv. To provide information and education / useful knowledge and the medical advice, to general public regarding the vices of the society like Smack, Smoking (Cigarette / Biri / Hukka), Use of Alcohol/Wine, AIDS etc. through holding awareness camps for De-addiction and also organize the lectures by Expert Team of Doctors, Journalists, Lawyers, Professionals, and other learned persons.
- v. To arrange and organize EYE and BLOOD donation Camps all over in India.
- vi. To construct, repair and maintain hospitals, medical schools, medical colleges, nursing institutions, dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centers, cemeteries and burial grounds

BELIF OF THE POOR;

To establish, maintain or grant aid to homes for the aged, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy and destitute people, orphans, widows and aged persons.

To establish and develop institutions for the physically handicapped and disabled or mentally retarded persons and to provide them education, food, clothing or other help. Jantian Ati

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- iii. To make adequate arrangements and start the rehabilitation centers of destitute, widows, old man and women, poor, beggars, handicapped, blinds, deaf, dumb, mentally retarded and for other needy people.
- iv. To organize seminars on social justice, educational and economical upliftment to raise legal demands and fundamental rights provided by the Constitution of India.
- v. To promote the cause of <u>national</u> integration and unity of India and to fight against the forces of separatism in India.
- vi. To establish, maintain or grant aid for the establishment or maintenance of wells, tube wells, tanks, water reservoirs, trees and also to make the construction and maintenance of paths, roads, bridges, parks, sewerages and other buildings and institutions which are used by the general Public.
- vii. To take up effective, reasonable, and lawful steps for the solution of the problems relating to the blind, handicapped, mentally handicapped, deaf, dumb and other disabled through the various kinds of training programs and providing them required facilities to make them independent.
- viii. To provide food, clothes, shelter (temporary /permanent), medicines and other required facilities to the people who have faced the Natural Calamity and / or the disaster.
- ix. To carry on the business of providing Support Services whether information technology enabled or otherwise, including but not limited to providing back office services, enterprise content and data services, business analysis, business intelligence, advertising, public relations, business, commercial and administrative services in India and abroad.
- x. To provide physical training, judo karate, etc. to students or general people for self-defense purposes.
- xi. To create a sense of brotherhood, co-operation mutual harmony, love and affection amongst the Trusteer and also amongst the general public.

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xii. To take up effective but reasonable and lawful steps for the eradication of social evils such as wastage of money in the various functions and use of intoxicated drugs / wine / smack etc

xiii. To give, provide and/ or render monetary and / or help and assistance for the relief of persons and animals affected by the natural and other calamities such as flood, fire, famine, cyclone, earth quake, storm, accident, pestilence, drought, epidemic, unbearable cost of living and the like, to give donations, subscriptions, or contributions to institutions, establishments, centers or persons doing relief work on such occasion.

xiv. To start various programs against child labour and to take up effective but reasonable and lawful steps on this connection for the welfare of children.

xv. To provide nursing aid to the needy people especially for the old agemen and women, orphan, ill etc.

xvi. To organize meeting/meetings of general public for uplifting socio- economic condition or to discuss any issue relating to environment, health, education, culture, social evil, etc.

xvii. To promote the interest of people in Environment, Sense of Integration, Self Employment, and Sanitation etc.

xviii. To organize Seminars, Meetings, Press- Conferences and other Lawful gatherings from time to time.

xix. To take up effective, reasonable and lawful steps for the solution of the problems relating to the Trust and / or relating to the General Public.

xx. To accept donations, grants , presents, gifts, and others offerings in the shape of moveable and / or immoveable properties for attainment of the aims and objects of the Trust.

xxi. To hold and manage the assets and properties acquired / inherited or purchased by the Trust as may be necessary or appropriate for the achievement of the objectives of the Trust.

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ransfer, improve, develop, manage and the above Trust, necessary or convenient for the purpose of attainment of the aims and objects of the Trust.

xxiii. To contribute for the construction of any community hall, dharma Sala, hostel, boardinghouse, library, reading rooms, wedding hall etc., for use by the general | public.

xxiv. To publish Books, Charts, Illustrations, Journals, Magazines, Periodicals, News Letters/ Papers and other publications in the different languages and on the different subjects

and various N.G.Os whose aims and objects are commensurate with this Trust.

xxvi. To do such other things / acts / activities which are necessary and which may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of any of the object of the Trust.

xxvii. The activities and the branches shall spread all over in India.

xxviii. The Trust will invest its money and funds according to the Section - 11(5) of the Income-Tax Act, 1961.

11. POWER FUNCTIONS OF THE SETTLER/PRESIDENT:

i. The Settler may appoint any person as employee, manager, supervisor, legal advisor and legal assistant, accountant, cashier, peon, chowkidar etc. He shall have also the powers to terminate the services of any staff as he may deem fit and proper for the benefit of the Trust.

ii. The Settler shall have the power to caste two votes in the case of tie or in difference opinions, decisions, understanding or any disputes arises amongst the Trustees regarding any issues on behalf of the Trust.

iii. The Settler may delegate his/her power to the board of trustees or the committee of the trustees.

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OWER FUNCTIONS OF THE SECRETARY:

îv. The Secretary will convince all the meeting of the trust as per the instructions of the President. Date of meeting will be fixed by him.

He shall prepare, spend of a meeting under the direction of the President.

He shall maintain the office and all registers of the trust under the supervisions of the President. vii.

He should get the accounts audited according to rules.

viii. He should deposit in the bank all the collections made as soon as possible

POWER FUNCTIONS OF THE TREASURER:

The treasurer will act under the direction of the ix. committee.

Any amount exceeding Rs. 10000/- which is not X. required for immediate use shall be paid into such bank or banks as may be approved or by the committee. The treasurer shall ordinarily receive all payments and disburse the amount passed by the president/Secretary and shall maintain proper books of accounts.

Treasurer shall maintain the account in proper and xi. prescribed form. He shall deposit and withdraw the amount of the trust in the bank or in the post office with the signatures of any two of the secretary, president or treasurer

FRAMING OF RULES AND BYE LAWS:

The Trustees may frame Rules and Bye laws for the management of the Trust, its properties, institutions, personal staff and amend or rescind them as they deem fit.

15. REGISTER OF MEMBERSHIP:

A register is the form prescribed by the board of management will be with their age, occupation and full address which will be seen in the office during office hours.


CATEGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP:

17. MEMBERSHIP:

The membership of the trust shall be opened to all men and women who have attained the age of 21 years and subscription and fees and must be citizen of India.

18. BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

The Board of trustees shall comprise of maximum 21 trustees and minimum of 7 trustees including the Settler. The Settler shall be managing Trustee for life. The vacancy on board of trustees shall be filled in by the managing trustee in his discretion for such term as stipulated at the time of their appointment.

The Board of Trustees shall nominate and invite person/persons to be the other trustees for such period, as they may deem fit and proper.

The Board of trustees may constitute committee/committees to make the trust functionable or more transparent.

The managing trustees/settler for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional Trustee within the number mentioned above for such period or on such terms as to retirement and re-appointment as the trustees for the time being considered proper. Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.

19. POWER, FUNCTION AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

For the furtherance of the objects of the trust and subject to the provisions of Income Tax Act, 1961 and any other law applicable to the Trust for the time being in force, the trustees shall have the following power, function and duties:-

- i. All property of the Trust Movable or Immovable or of any other kind, shall vest in trust, the trustees shall manage the whole property and affairs of the trust and shall have all powers, duties and functions necessary proper and incidental to the promotion and carrying out of the objects of the trust.
- ii. The general management and control of the Trust properties and its affairs shall be vested in the trustees and the trustees shall have power to do such acts as may be considered necessary for the benefit of the trust and / or management of its properties and affairs. Veto Power shall always remain with Settler, Nominees or the Successor (s).

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- iii. To appoint employees and to settle the terms of their service, remuneration and termination
- iv. To invest the funds of the trust, in bank or in the purchase of company shares or securities or other movable and movable and immovable properties subject to the provision of section 11(5) of Income Tax Act'1961.
- v. To sell, alter, vary, transpose or otherwise dispose or alienate the trust properties or any investment representing the same for consideration and to reinvest the same;
- vi. To pledge or mortgage the trust properties for raising loans;
- vii. To open Bank account/accounts in the name and on behalf of the trust and to operate the same;
- viii. To pay all charges, impositions and other outgoings payable inrespect of the trust properties and also to pay all cost of the incidental to the administration and management of the trust properties;
- ix. To file suit on behalf of the trust and to refer to arbitration all actions proceedings and disputes touching the trust properties and to compromise and compound the suits filed
- To accept any gift, donation or contribution in cash or in kind from anyone for the objects of the trust;
- xi. To seek legal opinion of lawyers and/or Chartered Accountants as and when required;
- xii. No trustee shall be responsible or liable for any loss or any act of omission or commission by his constituted attorney or agent or employees or other trustees unless occasioned by his willful neglect or default.
- xiii. If any trustee dies or retires or becomes incapable or unfit to act, the continuing or surviving trustee or trustees shall appoint a successor in the place of such trustee.
- xiv. To acquire purchase, very, sell convent, change, transfer, transpose or otherwise deal with all or any of the investments including shares, stocks, debentures, Govt. Securities belonging to the Trust or representing the Trust Fund/and to re-invest the same as the Trustees may deem fit and proper in accordance with the provisions of Income Tax Act.

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xv. To apply and get registered under Section 12A, 80 G of the Income Tax Act.

xvi. To accept donations, contributions, gifts and / or other grant-in -aid either in money or in kind.

xvii. To receive CSR fund from corporate and others.

xviii. To receive foreign fund from corporate and others with the approval or grant in FCRA Act, 2010 as amended time to

xix. To receive financial and non-financial assistance from Govt., Non- Govt. Organization, NGO, Trust and from any other legal or corporate entities.

xx. To receive financial and non-financial assistance from International Agencies, International organization, International NGO, banks or any other legal entity or from individual subject to the provisions of Income Tax Act, 1961 and any other law applicable to the Trust for the time being in forcer

xxi. To enter into any contract and borrow money for the purpose of the Trust and management of its properties and assets.

xxii. To institute suits, actions and legal proceedings, to prefer appeals, to make applications or petitions, and to give affidavits, wherever necessary and to defend or compound, compromise, abandon, submit to arbitration or otherwise settle any suit, action, claim, legal proceedings, appeal, demand or dispute relating to the trust matters.

xxiii. To apply the whole or any part of the Trust Fund (Corpus and/ or income) or property for the objects and purposes of the trust and to set apart the whole or part of the income of the Corpus or Part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.

practitioners, agents etc. and to delegate the duties and powers vested in them (Trustees) with regard to the management of the Trust property including starting or defending of legal proceedings or for opening or operating upon accounts with any bank (s), person(s), firm(s) or to do such other acts and duties relating to or connected with the Trust property as may be deemed necessary.

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To put up suitable buildings or other constructions to maintain, alter and equip them suitably with machinery and other things and to the discretion of the Trustees to permit their use on lease or license to institutions or organizations devoted to the objects which are similar to those of the Trust.

xxvi.

To amalgamate the Trust with other institution, association, Trust or organization having public charitable objects and purposes with the consent of two Third of Trustees in writing.

xxvii.

The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the Trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.

xxviii.

To keep proper accounts of the Trust Fund and its Property.

xxix.

To Set up a committee of the trustees for any special purpose.

xxx.

To appoint / nominate patrons and to give such other designations to various persons extending help for the running or for the case of the Trust.

xxxi.

And generally to do all acts, deeds and things as may be necessary for administration of the Trust.

20. BOOKS OF ACCOUNTS:

The Trust shall keep and maintain proper books of account and other relevant documents relating to all its assets, liabilities, income, expenditure, receipts and payments relating to the Trust at its registered office and in case the Trust prefers to open branches, books of accounts and other documents of the branches may be kept and maintained at the respective branch. Further the books of accounts of the Trust will be audited by a qualified accountant.

The accounting period of the trust shall be from 1st April to 31st March, however the period may be changed by the Trustees by passing appropriate resolution by 2/3 majority at General Body meeting of the Trust.

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OPERATION OF BANK ACCOUNT:

a) The Board of Trustees may open Bank Account or Accounts in any Banks in the name of the Trust such accounts shall be operated by the President and Secretary or by such person as authorized by the board of trustees from time to time.

b) The trust may open Bank Account/s in the name of institution/organization funded by the Trust. Such Bank Account/s shall be operated by the President or by such person as authorized by the board of trustees from time to time.

22. VACANCIES:

Any vacancy among the Members of the Board of Trustees may be filled by the trustees as specified in para (10) above or their successors and they shall hold office for such duration as may be specified by the Board of Trustees.

23. NOTICE:

Seven days Notice shall ordinarily be given in writing or through e-mail or any other electronic media for a meeting of Board of Trustees.

24. MEETING OF THE BOARD OF THE TRUSTEES:

The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of Trustees. In the absence of such regulations:-

(a) Two Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustee.

(b) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustees.

(c) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of two thirds of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.

25. OTHER TERMS:

 The Board of Trustees shall be entitled to sue in the name of the Trust and may similarly be sued in the name of the Trust. Md. Comb ... Sames M. 06/06/124 NOOR E Amore 08/06/24

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- ii. The Trustee will not be entitled to receive the remuneration as the Trustees but may reimburse themselves for all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with Trust or their dues thereto.
- iii. The Trustees may from time to time, frame Rules for the conduct of the administration of the Trust and regulating the meetings of the Trustees. In the Absence of such regulations:
 - a. All the matters will be decided by the majority and the quorum for the meeting shall be two third,
 - b. A resolution circulated to all the Trustees and signed by the majority of such Trustees shall be as valid and effectual as resolution duly passed at a meeting of the trustees.
- iv. It is hereby declared that no part of the Trust Property or its income shall be applied for any purpose other than objects of the Trust as understood under the Income Tax Act for the time being in force, and the surplus funds if any of the trust shall be invested as per the provided the Income Tax Act.
- v. The trustees shall be Trustees for their life time but any trustee may resign by giving in writing to the Co - Trustees. Appointment of Trustee (s) shall be only with the final approval of Settler/ His Nominee (s) or the Successor(s).
- vi. The Trustees may accept donations, grants, subscriptions, aids or contributions from any person, Government, Local authorities or any other charitable institutions, in cash or in kind including immovable property without any incumbrance, but the Trustees shall not accept any receipt with any condition or terms inconsistent with the objects of the Trusts. While applying such receipts to the objects, the Trustees shall respect the directions, if any, by the granter. Any receipt with specific direction to treat the same as part of the corpus of the Trust or separate fund shall be funded accordingly.
- vii. a) The Settler or Trustees shall hold every year an Annual General Meeting. The Trustees may from time to time, hold ordinary meeting for day to day business or any special business of the Trust. A seven days notice will be issued by the Managing Trustee to all the Trustees before calling an Annual General Meeting or any other meeting of the general body.

26. TERMINATION OF OFFICE OF THE TRUSTEES

The office of the Trustee shall become vacant on the happening of any of the following events:-

- a) Death of a Trustee,—
- b) Physical or mental inefficiency of a Trustee,
- c) Resignation of a Trustee,
- d) If he is adjudged insolvent or found guilty of an offence involving moral turpitude.
- e) If he is found to have acted against the interest of the Trust.
- f) If it is unanimously decided by the Trustees that his continuation in the Office is against the interest of the Trust.
- g) Upon expiry of the period up to which the Board of trustees have nominated the trustee
- h) On being convicted for any criminal offence involving moral turpitude.
- i) On being declared insolvent.

27. AMENDMENTS:

- a. Under no circumstances, any amendments to the original Trust Deed shall be made unless it is required by or under any law.
- b. No amendments to the Trust <u>Deed</u> shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of Section 2(15), 11, 12 and 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1964 as amended from time to time.

28. DISSOLUTION:

The Trust hereby created is irrevocable. However, if for any reason this trust fails or it is resolved to dissolve this Trust at any future time, the trustees shall transfer all the assets and liabilities, properties, institutions and Fund to charitable trust or Society whose objects are similar to those of this Trust and which enjoys recognition U/s 80G of Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time. The Assets remaining as on the date of dissolution of the Trust shall under no circumstances be distributed among the Trustees.
